

### DANIEL R. OLSEN AMERICAN LEGION POST 594 POST MEETING MINUTES March 21, 2023

The regular post meeting was held in the conference room at Cedarvale Lanes in Eagan. A social hour was held from 1815-1900, with regular post business beginning at 1900, and concluding at 2030.

Neil Hetherington, Commander of Cadets at St. Thomas Academy presented the Wall That Heals hosted by STA in Mendota Heights on May 26-29 this year. He requested volunteers and passed out flyers for Post members to sign up and attend the event.

#### Old Business: .

- **Sign-In Roster**: There is a new sign in roster format that allows for better tracking of information changes (e.g., email, phone number), and volunteer hours.
- Oratorical Contest: Paul Kovach
- **Post 449 Report:** Cindy Yanchury reported that Troop 449 is looking for assistance to work with scouts toward earning citizenship merit badges (community, nation, world, society). Anyone interested should contact Cindy and she will provide information regarding the process and time commitment.
- Youth Outreach: Cindy Yanchury shared the book "America's White Table." This is a children's book that seeks to help children understand and appreciate the sacrifices of armed forces members and their families.
- **Post 594 2022 Accomplishments:** Commander Beierman presented a summary of Post 594 accomplishments in 2022. A proposed calendar for 2023 was discussed and approved.
- Post 594 Goals for 2023: The identified goals included.
  - Youth education/activities (e.g., scouts, elementary age students, high school and Legion Baseball);
  - Post social events (identified in the 2022 Post survey)
  - Veteran's support (e.g., buddy checks, veterans' home)
  - Post mentorship (succession planning for Post leadership).
- Auxiliary: Post 594 Auxiliary was present with the goal of ongoing collaboration to support the goals of Post 594 and the Auxiliary. To develop a respectful and beneficial relationship with the Post. With a Goal is to fill the role of 2nd Vice-Commander to coordinate social activities for the Post. This serves two purposes to:
  - Facilitate comradeship amongst members.
  - Create a family environment that may appeal to younger veterans with children and other activities.
  - Post to support the Auxiliary with fund rising & activities their community outreach & Poppy sales.

#### New Business:

- The Core Leadership Group met on February 28. FunFest, Fundraiser 2023 Look Ahead, Fundraisers Two measures were discussed, voted on, and approved at the meeting.
- **Treasurer's report**: Adjutant Rayman. \$10, 048.44. Income: \$750 membership revenue, \$500 EHS. \$180 Expenses: Membership transmittals to National & State Legion.
- Membership report: Vice Commander Graham report
- **Scoops for Troops:** Not at this time since Tribute to the Troops who supported Gold Star families has disbanded. Most went to Minnesota Wheels of Honor.
- **Communications/Media**: Core Group Recommendations: Discussed possible areas of improvement in the communications area, including a post Gmail account, text communication for Post reminders and updates, a Post Sign Up Genius account to assist in volunteer sign up, and remote access to Post meetings. David Hammer Post Historian and Communications Lead outlined that the Post is developing a Post email and twitter accounts to disseminate Post activities and updates, and a separate Post email account tied to a Post Sign Up Genius

account to facilitate organizing events and volunteer opportunities. Current cost is expected to be less that \$20 per month. These are priority items as look toward several Post events coming up this spring and summer.
